Overall Guidelines

- Flags must always be flown the correct way up
- Appropriate flags are to be flown in the order of precedence by section number

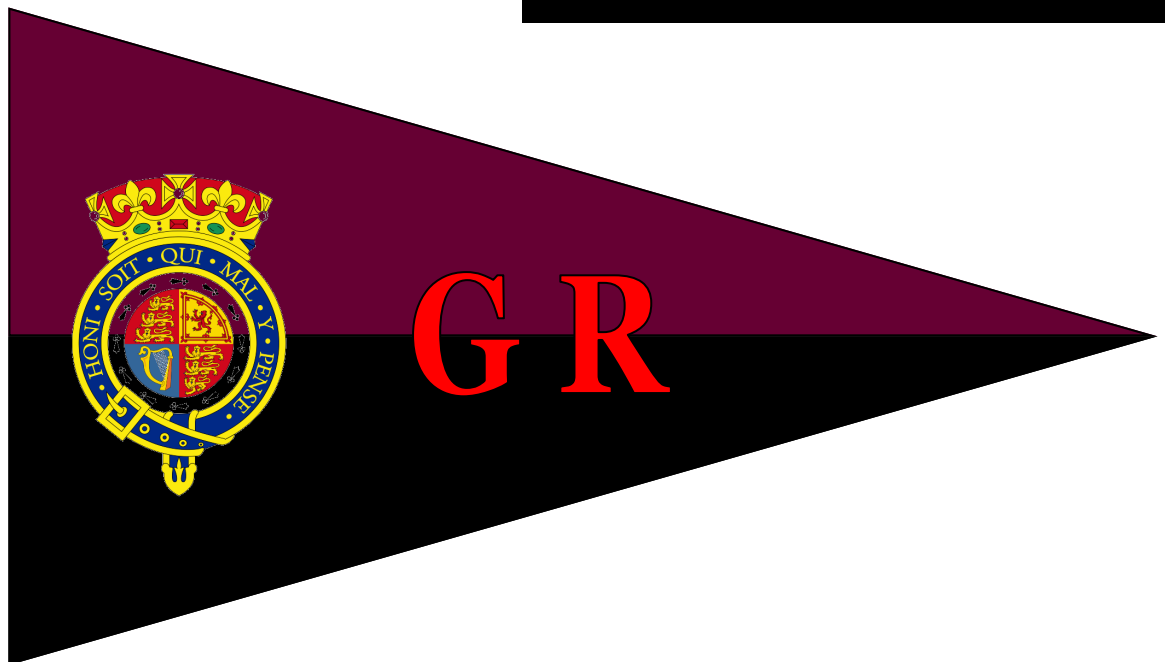
Section 1: National Flag

May be flown from any structure owned by a subject of the Kingdom of Verac



Section 2: King's Flag

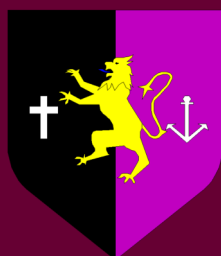
Must be flown from any structure in which the King is present. Either one of the rectangular designs may be used on buildings, the triangular pennant is for use on vehicles



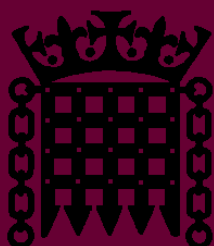
Section 3:

Government/Parliament Flags

May be flown from any structure used by the relevant Government Office or Parliament of the Kingdom of Verac. Flags may be adapted as suitable.



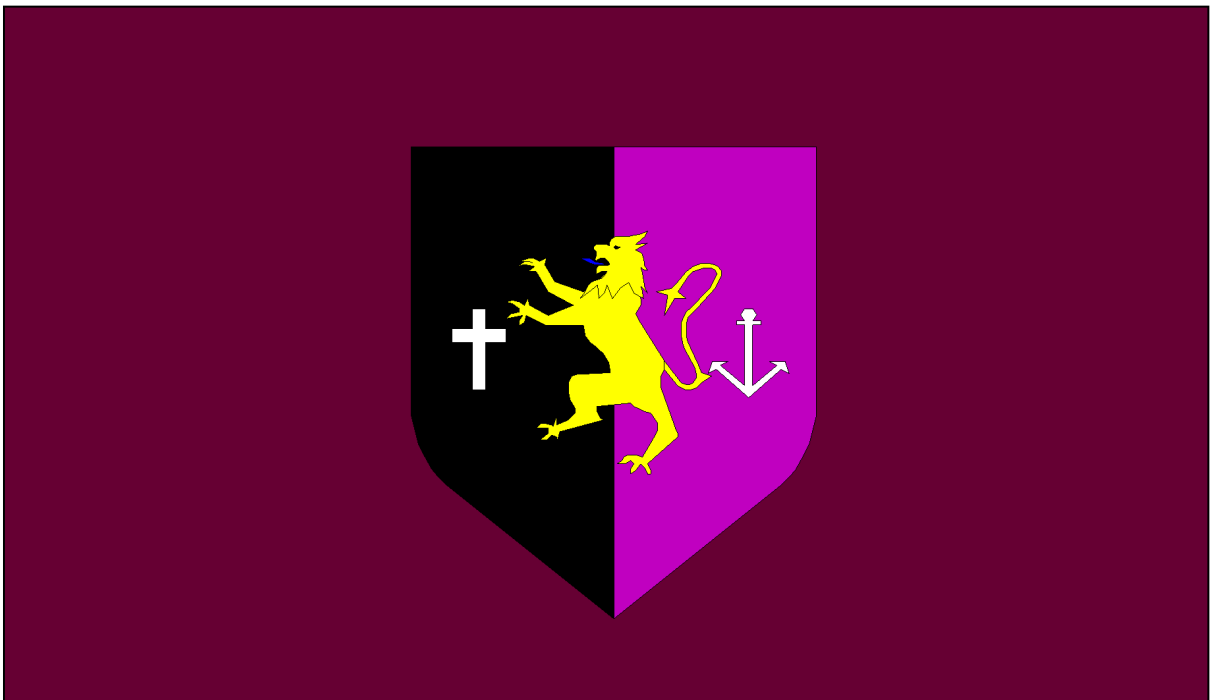

Section 4: National Arms

May be flown when specifically allowed by Order-In-Council.



Section 5: Armed Forces Flags

May be flown from any structure used by the relevant service of the Kingdom of Verac

Section 6: Royal Constabulary

May be flown from any structure utilised by the Royal Constabulary. Flags may carry the words ‘Connétables’, ‘Constabulary’ or ‘Police’ in any combination. However, ‘Connétables’ should only be used with the French-language badge and vice versa.
